Purpose

This paper presents a flowchart to help with considering whether members need to make a declaration of interest in any proceedings, and if so sets out appropriate statements to make.

Recommendation

The Board is requested to:

a) Note the flowchart supporting consideration of declarations of interest.

Declarations of Interest

- I. As members are aware, the process of considering and, where necessary, making declarations of interest is a key component of the Code of Conduct, and in ensuring the integrity of members and their public bodies.
- 2. The Standards Commission for Scotland's most recent professional briefing was recently circulated to all members. This briefing document included a link to a flowchart produced by Aberdeenshire Council supporting decision making on declarations of interest. While this flowchart is tailored to considering declarations of interest in a local authority environment, it is also a useful reference document to assist members of Non-Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs) such as the Authority in considering their position as regards the need for any declaration of interest to be made on items of business.
- 3. The flowchart is therefore reproduced at Annex I to this paper for ease of reference.
