I think H2 - 25 houses - 12 of which council and other 13 'low' cost is ok

Regarding H1 (Carr Road) for 72 houses with an amended boundary removing the woodland- Carr road is completely inadequate to cope with the volume of traffic that would be created by 72 houses . I do NOT support 72 houses on the reduced footprint of H1. Without compulsory purchase, there is no way that Carr road could cope with additional traffic. There is no room to widen the road and /or create pavements. Given that the CNP did a site visit , I cannot understand how you squared up the safety issues of this site with extra traffic .

I feel the CNP has sat on this plan for many many months and have not added anything to it.
