Proposed Block Plan 1:200






- Site located at Pine Cottage, Crathie near A93;





Change of use of restaurant to bar Applicant : Mr G. Maclennan








- Planning Permission sought for change of use and conversion of 'Ski-ing Doo' restaurant in Aviemore to bar and beer garden;


