Application REFERENCE NO 10/08227/FUL.

With reference to the proposed development at the rear of 129. Grampian Road. which is a "B" listed Building. The applicant has been refused planning permission on three previous occasions by the planning authorities namely The National Park and The Community Council have voiced their views on the matter stating that the buildings would not fit in with the surrounding area. The existing building is being used as a Bed Breakfast and self catering establishment. The grounds at the front of the building have been altered to accommodate car parking and at the rear a wooden fence has been erected to separate the grounds where the proposed development is to take place.

At present the grounds can only be described as a wilderness. It is being used for dumping rubble and rubbish which indicates to me that the applicant has no respect for the adjoining properties or the authorities.

I am objecting to the development on the following grounds.
