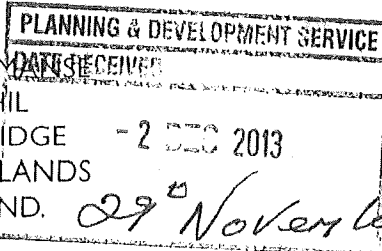

weeds blowing into our garden

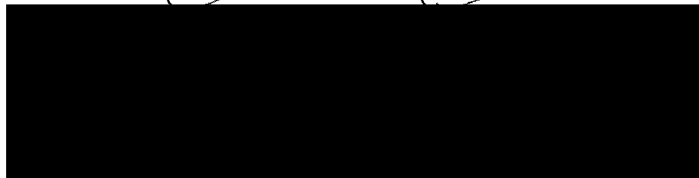
causing a huge amount of work
