
















114ha of Scots pine plantation restructuring

In the first 9 months of 2019:

- The total value of contracts awarded across the CC partnership is over £632k.
- over £55k has been spent on materials, equipment and services; £45k of this was spent within 50 miles of the project area.
- CC partners spent over £2m in the project area.












- 347 cuttings collected and planted in the Cairngorms Connect tree nursery...
- ...from 205 individual montane willows, of 5 different species plus 2 hybrids.
- Leaf samples have been sent to the Royal Botanic Gardens Edinburgh for genetic testing. This will inform further collection and planting, to ensure genetic diversity.






Wildland Limited have established 550ha of new native woodland planting, accelerating woodland recovery far from seed sources.
