


KEY POINTS

- •Minor change of use from one commercial use to another at site within Ballater






KEY POINTS


- •Previous planning consent for conversion of steading granted by Highland Council with condition that the area shown in drawing above is used as guest accommodation
- •Application seeks to remove this condition so that the section of the building shown would have a residential use in its own right.
- •CNPA didn't call-in earlier application at site and conversion of traditional buildings to residential is generally acceptable in principle by planning policy
- •The change proposed by the condition is not considered to raise issues of general significance.

- •Materials include slate roof, natural stone walls and timber window frames and doors
