


## **KEY POINTS**

- •Application seeks to renew planning permission for a single caravan at the Columba House Hotel for staff accommodation
- •Site within settlement and in grounds of Hotel
- •CNPA did not call-in pervious application

**RECOMMENDATION: NO CALL-IN** 

**COMMENT:** As with previous application the caravan should be given temporary permission only <u>View Planning Application</u>



Erection of 2 blocks of flats (4 houses in total)
Applicant: The Highland Council




## **KEY POINTS**

- •Site Located within Kingussie on site of storage building formerly used by Highland Folk Museum
- •Planning Permission in Principle sought for 4 -2 bed affordable flats
- •Two storey buildings indicated with parking in between
- •Flats proposed by Highland Council as affordable housing
- •In principle the proposal represents infill on white land within the settlement
- •Proposal not considered to raise issues of general significance

## **RECOMMENDATION: NO CALL-IN**

**COMMENTS:** CNPA welcome the principle of affordable housing. Application should be accompanied by a design statement and any future detailed application should produce buildings that are of an appropriate design and are sympathetic in terms of siting, scale, form and materials with the traditional buildings either side of the site. The indicated rear block may impact on significant trees which distinguish the site from St Columba's category B listed church, they should be retained.
