Title: STRATEGIC RISK REGISTER UPDATE

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Purpose

Recommendations

- b) Consider whether members have any further updates which should be incorporated into the Strategic Risk Register, including any additional risks not currently incorporated.

Executive Summary

The Authority's current strategic risk register is presented as the Annex to the Committee's Annual Report to the Board presented elsewhere on the agenda for the Committee's meeting. The current strategic risk register has been developed following email correspondence with Committee members in order to support its onward submission to the Board as part of the Committee's annual report.

It is appropriate for the risk register to be reviewed as usual by the Committee at this meeting. Any significant changes can be reported to Board in conjunction with the Committee's annual report. Email correspondence leading up to this meeting has suggested that the Committee may wish to consider:

- a) Length of the risk register and whether some risks may now be removed as adequately managed or mitigated;
- b) Coverage of the register, in particular whether some risks are more shared risks for consideration in structures supporting the National Park Partnership Plan rather than risks relating directly to the Authority, delivery of its functions and strategic corporate objectives;
- c) As usual, whether there are any additional risks not currently covered.
