Live Cases

Case 3 NEW Ballater, Glen Fenzie- There have been a number of complaints raised via the Mountaineering Council of Scotland and Ramblers Scotland who have reported a number of new gates on the track up to Morven Lodge. Concerned members of the public did raise the matter with Estate staff who instructed them to climb the gates.

Case 8 NEW Kingussie, Glen Tromie- There has been an increasing problem with off road parking and illegal vehicle access near Glen Tromie. The estate installed a simple barrier to deal with this issue but it has proved to be an obstacle for local horse riders. Currently the Estate is looking at other alternatives.
