Development priorities for 2014-15

- 2. Deliver a new outdoor access strategy for the Cairngorms National Park: Active Cairngorms.
- 3. Speyside Way extension:
 - a. Construct route from Aviemore to Speybank (in partnership with COAT).
 - **b.** Prepare a project delivery plan for extending the route to Newtonmore.
- 4. Deliver an improvement plan for existing Speyside Way.
- 5. The CNPA will continue to assert, protect and promote outdoor access (as per legislative requirements).

Budget

- 6. The CNPA budget for access development is tightly restrained for 2014-15.
- 7. It is unlikely that funds will be available for additional partnership projects this year.
