I. Members are informed that CNPA will be developing a new outdoor access strategy for the Cairngorms National Park. The strategy will be titled *Active Cairngorms*.

Background

- 2. The previous outdoor strategy for The Cairngorms National Park: *Enjoying the Cairngorms* (2007-2012) is due for renewal.
- 3. A CNPA project team has been set up to deliver a new outdoor access strategy by April 2015. The project will deliver an outdoor access strategy for the Cairngorms National Park that:
 - a) integrates with other NP strategies (especially Cairngorms Nature) to deliver effective spatial strategy;
 - b) promotes a partnership approach to reducing physical inactivity and increasing active travel;
 - c) empowers local communities to participate in and develop a sense of responsibility for their National Park;
 - d) deliver's outstanding visitor and learning experiences focused on key priorities.
