Comment: There can be little doubt even within the Cairngorm National Park the Braes of Glenlivet is a special area of historic interest (not only Scalan but also its crofting history) and scenic beauty that should be preserved.

Whilst the proposed siting of the turbine may be 'the back of beyond' that is the reason it should remain untouched.

The area is popular with walkers and the turbine, particularly with its moving paddles will stick out like a sore thumb to those who walk along the tops of The Ladders and other hills surrounding the Braes. Likewise for those who follow the course of the River Livet which passes close to the proposed siting.

Many visitors to the Braes of Glenlivet go there to enjoy its tranquility and particularly so those on a pilgrimage to the historic Scalan site from where I believe the paddles of the turbine will be visible.

Agreement to this planning application must clearly be seen as the setting of a precedent which will lead to further applications. In time we could see the whole attraction of visiting the Braes of Glenlivet destroyed from being as at present a special place of great historical interest and scenic beauty.
