



Applicant(s): Mr And Mrs Graeme Trotter

Proposal: Extension to existing sitting room and improvements to existing bathroom and kitchen



- •Full planning permission is sought for a pitched roof extension to the south of an existing detached house.
- •This site is located in a rural location outside Nethy Bridge.
- •The proposed extension will match the existing house in terms of proportions and finishes.
- •This proposal of a minor domestic nature and is not considered to raise issues of significance to the collective aims of the National Park

Proposal: Refurbishment and extension of existing agricultural outbuilding to house services for agricultural estate; including transformer, water tank & water treatment utility & ground source heat pump






•Full planning permission is sought for a pitched roof extension to an existing agricultural outbuilding to house equipment including ground source heat pump.

The site is located to the south east of Kingussie at Killiehuntly farm complex where an agricultural notification for alterations to the farm steading was dealt with by Highland Council earlier this year.


•The proposed design and finishes are sympathetic to the building with use of pitched slated roof and timber walls.

This proposal is of a fairly minor nature, and does not raise any issues of significance to the collective aims of the National Park.



Proposal: Erection of Car Port (Bat Roost Loft)





- •Full planning permission is sought to erect an open sided small car port of simple design, with bat roost above.
- •Finishes are slate roof and timber.
- •The site is located at Pine Lodge, a wooded rural location near Crathie.
- •An application is currently pending for the demolition of the existing house at Pine Lodge and replacement by new one.
- •With that application evidence was found of bats roosting in the existing house, and mitigation was required.
- •This small scale proposal is not considered to raise any issues of significance to the aims of the National Park.




Applicant(s): Glenprosen Estate

Proposal: Variation in Condition I attached to Planning Application I 2/00320/Full for the construction of New Private Water Supply Tank Room & Associated Earthworks and Access Track, to permit the development to commence within 3 years from the date of the permission






- •This application seeks permission to vary a condition of recently granted consent to permit a longer time period for work to start on site.
- •The original decision notice required work to start by 31 October 2012, and this application seeks to vary this to allow the standard three year time limit for commencement of work to apply.
- •It is not proposed to vary any other aspect of the proposal which was previously granted by Angus Council, and involves the construction of a new private water supply tank room, associated earth works and access track near Runtaleave Cottage in Glen Prosen.
- •The previous application was not considered to raise any issues of significance to the collective aims of the National Park, and similarly this is the case with this proposal to extend the time period for starting work.



Proposal: Proposed extension






- •Full planning permission is sought to extend Tomintoul Fire Station at Main Street , Tomintoul
- •The proposed extension is of pitched roof design and located to the rear of the existing building the front elevation will remain unchanged.
- •The extension will accommodate police and ambulance offices.
- •Proposed finishes are timber cladding and grey standing seam metal roof.
- •This proposal to provide additional facilities at an existing community facility within the settlement boundary is not considered to raise any issues of significance to the aims of the National Park.




Applicant(s): Upland Developments Ltd

Proposal: 2 No extensions to dwelling houses 183 & 184 and internal alterations




- •Full planning permission is sought for extensions to a pair of semi detached houses at Dalnabay, Aviemore.
- •The houses are located within an existing housing development, and back onto open land.
- •The extensions are relatively small and of pitched roof design.
- •The proposals are of a minor domestic nature within a settlement, and are not considered to raise issues of significance to the collective aims of the National Park.

Proposal: Installation of boiler with flue





- •Full planning permission is sought to form a biomass boiler with flue at an existing house
- •The flue will be formed in the back wall of the house.
- •The property is located in Nethybridge.
- •The proposal is of a minor domestic nature and is not considered to be of significance to the collective aims of the National Park.
