Purpose

To present a summary of the Development Phase of the Tomintoul & Glenlivet Landscape Partnership – the Tomintoul & Glenlivet Hidden Histories Project – since the permission to start Delivery Phase.

Recommendations

The Finance and Delivery Committee is requested to:

a) Note the update of the Delivery Phase since Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) permission to start on 23 November 2016.

Executive Summary

- 1. 31 January is end of month 4 in the detailed budget and projections approved by HLF. Due to the timing of the permission to start, the programme manager taking up post on 23rd January, the project has not incurred any material expenditure.
- 2. The submitted budget anticipated project spend of £147,000 by the end of January. Therefore, a re-profiling exercise will be undertaken, and repeated every 3 months thereafter, to project cash flows.
- 3. The flagship project, the Museum Redevelopment, is expected to start w/c 30 January. The delay was due to revising the build scope and tender. The costs are higher than originally budgeted and an additional £36,700 has been made available to the project from the high level project contingency. The Development Trust has approximately £20,000 to find from other sources. It is anticipated the first invoice for the redevelopment will be received mid-March.
- 4. Partner cash contributions for FY16/17 have now been received in full from Chivas (Pernod-Ricard) [£5,000], Moray Council (£50,000) in addition to CNPA's £50,000.
