



LBC Alterations to valley gutters Applicant: NTS






Principle Elevation






•Proposal for renewal of temporary permission (period not specified) for 'laundry/office building' at Invercauld Holiday Lodges, Ballater;


•Proposal represents alterations to existing building within an established

#### **KEY POINTS**


•Proposal for compound and site huts as welfare and control facilities for local civil road works, associated with the Beauly-Denny OHL scheme;

•Would be located at rear of service station, which had previously been identified as a potential informal HGV turning area as part of other compound planning application recently approved by CNPA (10/264/CP);

•Concern at cumulative impact on village of this compound and the adjacent compound at the former lorry park site for SSE contractors, raising issues of landscape, and socio-economic for Dalwhinnie. As such the proposal raises issues of general significance.






Existing house
