Executive Summary

The Authority maintains a register of recommendations made by internal audit and through best value reviews (often undertaken as part of a complaint investigation) in order to monitor progress made in implementing agreed changes. This is presented in full in the Annex to this paper.

This is an internally generated document. Each year, the internal auditors undertake an independent follow-up review as part of the internal audit plan.

Where improvement actions have been completed, the entry has been shaded out in the Annex. The entry itself is retained in the register until the internal auditor confirms that action has been implemented, following which the entries are removed.
