



Hazardous Substance consent



- Proposal not considered to raise issues of general significance






Extension to shop unit (rear)



- Proposal not considered to raise issues of general significance







Proposal: Extension to house to form sunroom Applicant: Mr & Mrs B. Gallagher






Proposed sun lounge extension to rear

- The proposal is of a minor domestic scale and is not considered to raise issues of significance to the aims of the National Park.



Proposal: Installation of solar PV panels on hall roof Applicant: Boat of Garten Community Council








Proposed solar panels to hall roof

Proposal: Erection of fishing hut Applicant: Invercauld Estate



- Site located by River Dee at Crathie, Braemar;
