




Installation of 2 hydropower schemes and reconstruction of a dam Applicant: Pitmain Estate









View Planning Application

Proposal incorporates the construction of two intake weirs and two powerhouse buildings. It also includes the reconstruction of a dam and the installation of two sections of underground pipeline,


• Two open channels and two access tracks are also contained in the proposal.

•Work affects Allt Mhor and Gynack Burn.

• The proposed development involves the siting of various structures in and around sensitive water courses. It is considered to raise issues of general significance in terms of the natural and cultural heritage, the use of natural resources and the socio-economic development of the National Park. As such, the proposal raises issues of general significance to the aims of the National Park.


• Site located by Crathie, near Braemar;
