- 27. The Convenor advised the Committee that a late letter of representation had been received in relation to this application. As hortbreak was afforded to allow Members to read the letter.
- 28. The Convenor advised the Committee that the applicant's agent and one objector had requested to address the Committee. The Committee granted this request.
- 29. Neil Stewart presented a paper recommending that the Committee refuse the application for the reason stated in the report.
- 30. NeilGray, agent for the applicant, spoke in favour of the application.
- 31. SallySpencer, an objector, spoke against the application.
- 32. The Committee were given the opportunity to ask questions of the speakers and planning officers.
- 33. The Committeediscussedtheapplication and the following points were raised:
 - a) Concern was raised over the possible impact the extraction of water for this development could have on the long term water supply for other properties at Balgowan.
 - b) Members felt the description of the Balgowan community in Halcrow's report was misleading and in accurate.
 - c) Members felt that the design and scale of the proposed house was inappropriate in relation to the surrounding properties and also due to the prominenceofit's location in the landscape setting.

 - d) Membersfeltthat moretimeshouldbeaffordedtotheapplicanttoprovidea more robust Flood Risk Assessment to address concerns raised by SEPA andtheAberdeenshireCouncilFloodRiskPreventionUnit.
