  - a) Concern was raised over the possible impact the extraction of water for this development could have on the long term water supply for other properties at Balgowan.
  - b) Members felt the description of the Balgowan community in Halcrow's report wasmisleadingandinaccurate.
  - c) Members felt that the design and scale of the proposed house was inappropriate in relation to the surrounding properties and also due to the prominenceofit'slocationinthelandscap esetting.

  - c) The long term future of the building was discussed in relation to the potential for a tourism use and also the relative economic benefits to the community of tourist accommodation versus privately owned flats
  - d) Membersfeltthatmoretimeshouldb eaffordedtotheapplicanttoprovidea more robust Flood Risk Assessment to address concerns raised by SEPA andtheAberdeenshireCouncilFloodRiskPreventionUnit.
- 43. SallyDowdentabledaMotiontodeferdecisionontheapplicationtoaddressthe concerns over affordable housing provision and also to afford the applicant an opportunity to provide a more robust Flood Risk Assessment for the development.ThiswassecondedbyDavidGreen.
