




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### Applicant(s) : Proposal :

### Andrew Marshall, 3D Reid Relocation of the biomass boiler serving existing Kingussie High School, removal of the existing flue and erection of a new flue



•Full planning permission is sought to relocate a biomass boiler for Kingussie High School together with removal of existing flue and erection of new flue.

•This is necessary to accommodate an extension to the school.

•The biomass boiler will be housed in a timber clad building located beside the entrance to the school car parking area beside existing trees, behind the school.

•The boiler is currently located on the other (west) side of the school

•There have been a number of previous applications dealt with by Highland Council on this site for various facilities and extensions.

•The proposal is of a minor nature and required to accommodate other works to the School.


•It is not considered to raise issues of significance to the aims of the National Park




## **RECOMMENDATION : NO CALL IN**


# Applicant(s) :The Crown EstateProposal :Erect of steel portal frame extension and cladding of same



•Full planning permission is sought for provision of biomass heating and the subdivision of an existing ancillary extension to form a self contained holiday unit.


•Broomhill House is a category B listed building located near to Dulnain Bridge.

biomass heating, photovoltaic panels and minor internal alterations.


•This was not called in , being of a minor domestic nature.


•Similarly the current proposal, which largely involves minor changes and internal alterations is not considered to raise issues of significance to the aims of the National Park.

• Full planning permission is sought for a biomass heating plant cabin at the Glenmore Lodge complex by Aviemore.

•The cabin is of simple wooden , flat roofed design located between existing buildings

•There have been a number of previous applications on this site including solar panels, extensions and mountain bike trails.

•The proposal to provide a sustainable heating source is generally welcomed.

•This proposal is of a minor nature and is not considered to raise any issues of significance to the aims of the Park.
