


Full Planning Permission for erection of conservatory

Site of new air pump to rear of house


KEY POINTS

Minmore House Hotel, change of use back to private dwelling

KEY POINTS

Application for change of use of small hotel (which ceased trading in 2008) back to private dwelling
The applicants highlight that it was only run as a hotel for 6 months of the year and 'in commercial terms never generated a profit.' Proposal retains a self-catering unit within the grounds of the house.
While the loss of tourist accommodation is unfortunate in this instance it is not considered to raise issues of general significance, comments to be made.

APPLICANTS: Smiths Gore C/O Mr D. Pethick

RECOMMENDATION: NO CALL-IN

COMMENTS: Ask that Moray Council satisfy themselves the loss of the hotel is acceptable and doesn't undermine the range and quality of accommodation on offer as per the requirements of CNP Policy 33 Tourism-Related Developments.
