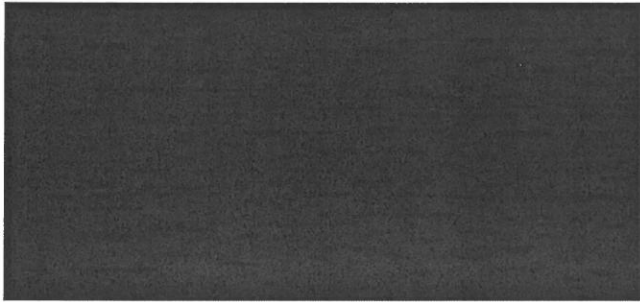

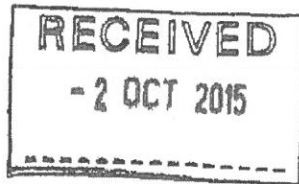

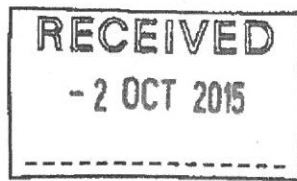

I am writing to support the ~~pl~~ Planning application of Alister and Ingrid Kendall for a house and stable block on the Glebe field Nethybridge.

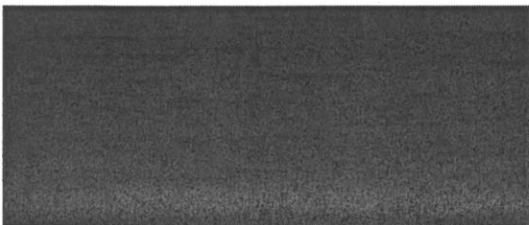
