The impacts of the wider scheme have previously considered by the CNPA as consultee. The proposed development is not considered to raise issues of significance to the collective aims of the National Park and, again, the main elements of the infrastructure (in particular the revised dam design which is the only proposed change) lie outwith the National Park boundary. The Local Authority has consulted CNPA landscape officer.
