**Purpose:** To highlight progress in areas of work, identify where additional

resource may be required and put in place actions to minimise the

risks associated with specific activities.

I. The Cairngorms Nature Strategy Group has an operational role in overseeing the implementation of the Cairngorms Nature Action Plan and allocating resources to ensure its delivery in a collective and coordinated manner.

- 2. The action Plan has a total of 176 actions. It is deemed impractical to maintain an overview of progress reporting at this level of detail. Therefore the reporting process has been broken down into the areas of work in the plan.
- 3. Reporting summarises some of the main activities to give a flavour of what's happening in the National Park and highlights some concerns for the Strategy Group to consider what, if anything, might be done to address them (Annex I).
- 4. Risks and/or concerns with a high impact, or medium impact with a rising trend, have been highlighted and described separately in a risk register (Annex 2).
