- 20. 2012/0120/DET Conversion of an Existing Stable to a Self Contained Flat At Cairnacay, Main Street, Tomintoul AB37 9HA
 - The Masterplanning exercise which was recently undertaken in Tomintoul supports the development of existing buildings and infill sites in the village in order to retain the character of the settlement whilst supporting the economic regeneration of the area. The proposal to convert the existing stable into residential accommodation should secure the future of this building and fits well with the aims and objectives of the Masterplan and Regeneration Strategy. It is also recommended in the event of the granting of planning permission, that an appropriate condition be included to ensure that the development is retained as ancillary accommodation to the main dwelling house on the site.
