- The choice of materials to be used and the financial management of the project should not expose the CNPA to a high level of risk.

- 1. This is work researching Gateway sign materials, supplier selection and project management for the initial prototyping in line with the request by the Board for further work to be carried out.

- 3. The value of this additional work is £12k and funds have been allocated for this work in the Operational Plan.
