#### Purpose

To update the Board on the indicative timetable for preparation of the next Cairngorms National Park Partnership Plan for the period 2022-2027.

#### Recommendation

That the Board:

a) Note the indicative timetable for preparation of the Cairngorms National Park Partnership Plan 2022-2027.

## Background

1. The National Park Partnership Plan (NPPP) is the statutory National Park Plan required by the National Parks (Scotland) Act 2000. It sets out the CNPA's policy and priorities for managing the National Park, coordinating the CNPA's functions and the functions of other public bodies that affect the National Park in order ensure the National Park aims are collectively achieved in a coordinated way. The current Cairngorms NPPP was approved by the Scottish Ministers in 2017 and runs to 2022.

### Indicative Timetable

2. The preparatory work to start developing the next plan to run from 2022 to 2027 has started, with reviews of evidence and initial work on statutory assessments underway. Table I shows the indicative timetable for preparation of the next NPPP to ministerial approval and adoption in 2022. The bulk of the work will be undertaken during 2021, with consultation on a draft NPPP being undertaken in the autumn/winter.
