I would be grateful if you could also let me know why this path has been added on at a very late stage to the core path network and provide me with evidence of this demand. I have been following the process closely and was astounded to see that this route had been put in at the last minute especially when it has gone in such a half-cocked fashion.

I fully appreciate that a landowner does not have to consent to a core path crossing their property but if construction of a new path is considered then I would have thought it was imperative to bring the land owner on side before committing a new route to paper.

The paths present navigational challenges requiring skills which members of the public might not expect to need on a route that is promoted by the Cairngorms National Park Authority.

The paths take walkers onto hazardous terrain.
