No changes are proposed.

2.1 The Local Plan's Vision is set out in para. 2.14 p9 of the Deposit Local Plan as modified. It takes this Vision from the adopted National Park Plan.

3.0 Summary of objection(s)

- 3.1 I objections raising I issue has been lodged on the general issue of the Vision in the Local Plan and wishes to be considered at a hearing:
 - In the DLP (para. 2.12 p9) the Vision linking to the Park Plan Vision will be difficult to sustain when measured against the historical record. Outcomes for Conserving and Enhancing Biodiversity and Landscapes for 2012 is not borne out in the housing allocations. Objection maintained in response to the Ist mDLP. (434b)

4.0 Summary of Cairngorms National Park Authority Response

4.1 The CNPA responded to the consultation on the Deposit Local Plan by taking the full Vision from the National Park Plan rather than the portion of it that was the Local Plan's Vision as set out in para. 2.12 p9 of the Deposit Local Plan. It takes this Vision from the adopted National Park Plan. The Local Plan's Vision is set out in para. 2.14 p9 of the Deposit Local Plan as modified. The outcomes and priorities are a quote from the National Park Plan and cannot be changed. The mDLP is a considered and balanced approach to delivering for the needs of the area's communities whilst conserving and enhancing the natural and cultural heritage of the area. Topic Paper I "Statutory National Park Context" (CD7.21) clearly sets out the context with regard to the statutory purpose of the CNPA and its local plan function. No further modifications are proposed.
