60% Eligibility

The land based business making the application must be based wholly or partly within the boundaries of the Cairngorms National Park.

Individuals whose training we support must:

- be aged between 20-25 years
- work at least 50% of their time on land inside the National Park
- have been in the employment of the business for 3 months or more.

Applications should outline a training programme that develops the young person's skills and abilities and must be for a minimum of 2 training events in a period of less than one year.

Training topics should be directly related to land management in the Park that are not available through alternative schemes.

Examples of training subjects supported

(NB. This list is not exhaustive):

- Management and leadership
- Ecological and habitat survey
- Monitoring and low carbon land management
- Soil analysis
- Pest control
- Management of woodlands and wetland
- Fencing
- Gamekeeping

40% Eligibility

The land based business making the application must be based wholly or partly within the boundaries of the Cairngorms National Park.

Individuals whose training we support must work at least 50% of their time on land inside the National Park

Applications should outline a training programme that develops the young person's skills and abilities and must be for a minimum of 2 training events in a period of less than one year.

Examples of training subjects supported

Training topics will be similar to those listed above and should be directly related to enhancing land management in the Park.

25% Eligibility

The land based business making the application must be based wholly or partly within the boundaries of the Cairngorms National Park.

Individuals whose training we support must work at least 50% of their time on land inside the National Park.

Applications should outline a training programme that develops the young person's skills and abilities and must be for a minimum of 2 training events in a period of less than one year.

Examples of training subjects supported

Training topics and courses are likely to be technical, for example, trailer driving, machinery use or national governing body qualifications for the outdoor education sector. Topics will not be directly related to enhancing land management in the Park, but will most likely carry a qualification accredited by organisations such as LANTRA, NPTC (National

Proficiency Tests Council, BCU (British Canoe Union), Mountain Leader Training, British Horse Society, British Association of Ski Instructors (BASI), etc, etc.
