The Cairngorms Uplands Advisory Group (CUAG)

Terms of reference

Function

The Cairngorms Uplands Advisory Group (CUAG) main functions:

- I. To promote better communication and understanding between all organisations with an interest in upland management in the Cairngorms National Park.
- 2. To advise the Cairngorms National Park Authority on upland management and, in particular, integration of the different land management sectors within the Park
- 3. To share examples of good practice and strengthen the skills base in the sector
- 4. To share latest research, relevant to upland management in the Cairngorms to inform future landuse strategy

Chair

CUAG should always be chaired by a CNPA Board Member. This chair will serve a three year term after which they may be re-elected for a further 3 years or a new chair sought. 6 years will be the maximum term.

Secretariat

CNPA will provide secretarial support which will include arranging meetings, setting agendas, arranging papers, taking and circulating minutes.

Meetings

CUAG will meet 2/3 times per year, depending on level of business to discuss.
