On behalf of Dalwhinnie Community Council, I am writing to confirm our full awareness of the flood defence designs proposed by the Dalwhinnie Flood Resilience Group under planning application reference 25/01652/FUL.

The applicant has engaged constructively with the Community Council and wider village residents in presenting the scope and intent of the works.

We are satisfied that the proposed flood mitigation and adaptation measures will offer meaningful protection to properties and infrastructure within Dalwhinnie that have historically been vulnerable to flooding. The designs reflect local concerns and incorporate practical, environmentally sensitive interventions.

Accordingly, Dalwhinnie Community Council fully endorses the proposals and supports their implementation. We believe the scheme represents a clear benefit to the local community by enhancing resilience, safeguarding homes and amenities, and contributing to long-term sustainability in the face of changing climatic conditions.
