Are you planning to look for capercaillie this spring?

Consider this...

There are only 542 capercaillie left in the UK.

Over **85% of those birds live in a handful of forests** in the Cairngorms National Park.

They are legally protected under UK law. This makes it a **criminal offence to disturb them** whilst they are breeding.

Disturbing capercaillie is one of the pressures that is causing the birds stress and **pushing them closer to extinction**.

This breeding season Lek It Be

Do not go looking for capercaillie from March to August.

Capercaillie need all our help to survive and you risk being arrested for criminal activity.
