Purpose of this Questionnaire

The Cairngorms National Park Local Development Plan (LDP) identifies a number of sites for future housing development, including site H1 at Carrbridge (see plan overleaf). Site H1 is allocated for up to 72 houses. However, two planning applications for housing development on the site were recently refused by the Cairngorms National Park Authority. It is acknowledged that these planning applications generated a significant amount of local objection. This leaves a level of uncertainty over the future development of this site.

As a result, we intend to produce a Development Brief for the HI site to provide more clarity on the key issues that any future development proposals should address. This should help to give more certainty for both local residents and the site developer. This questionnaire allows you to have your say on the issues that the Development Brief should cover.

It is important to be clear that this is not an opportunity to reconsider whether the HI site is appropriate for development in principle. However, it is an important opportunity for you to influence how the site could be taken forward in a way that benefits Carrbridge.
