Have had a quick look at MIR very disappointed that in Laggan the only issue seems to be Wolftrax. Have no objections to LFT developing the earmarked site,(a couple of forest crofts would be great) it is just that the CNP seem to disregard and ignore everything else going on in Laggan,

On page 5 In the paragraph headed "Why do we need a Local Development plan the last sentence states " to make the most of existing and new infrastructure such as roads, schools and health facilities." Laggan Bridge has the school, village hall medical centre and church, and at present an empty shop which the community has lots of ideas & hopes for. Laggan bridge also has the only public water supply and public septic tank. So why no mention of possible housing at Laggan Bridge.

[REDACTED] there are many in the community who agree with what she says, and the CNP do not help LFT by continuing to either ignore the rest of the community or try to turn

Wolftrax into the centre of Laggan rather than Laggan Bridge.

Sorry to give you this gripe but just know that I will get the complaints that will never reach the ears of CNP officials.
