Thank you for your email of 13 August, asking Historic Environment Scotland to comment on additional potential land allocations that have been identified through the Main Issues Report consultation. We understand that you consider that these sites are appropriate to bring forward for inclusion in the Proposed Plan.

We have looked at all the sites for our historic environment interests. We are content that the majority of the sites are not likely to have an adverse impact on heritage assets within our statutory remit. We have the following comments to offer on one site:

North Aviemore, Granish Site

The environmental assessment for this site should recognise that there is a scheduled monument (SM5899 Loch Nan Carraigan, Chambered Cairn & Stone Circle) in the vicinity. Whilst we do not consider that significant effects on the setting of the monument are likely, there is potential for some impact and we therefore recommend that the mitigation measures proposed for landscape impacts should also take account of the setting of the monument.
