Page 147 - H1

I am not opposed to houses on H1.

I am opposed to 36 houses on half the original H1 –the Boys Brigade/Bulls Field.

Clearly this means another 36 in the next plan on the other half.

I would prefer the whole field with 36 , or if to be half the field - 18.

The low cost/affordable requirement of 25% I would like to see at 45% as proposed for the CNPA large settlements.

However Carr road is narrow and is currently a dangerous mix of pedestrians of all age groups and skills and vehicular traffic some heavy haulage.

20mph at least , traffic calming and a suitable path away from Carr road to the school would need to be a requirement of approval.

Page 148 – H2
