Cairngorms National Park Active Cairngorms Action Plan Strategic EnvironmentalAssessment Post-adoption Report November 2024

# Introduction

This document is the Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) post-adoption report for the Cairngorms National Park Active Cairngorms Action Plan (ACAP), which was adopted in December 2023.

The environmental assessment process ran after this adoption and informed the revisions and final adoption of the Plan.

## **Context - post-adoption report requirements**

The Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 sets out six requirements for SEAs postadoption of plans at section 18(3). These can be summarised and combined. This results in a set of four matters that this post-adoption report requires to address:

- 1. Taking account of the environmental assessment: how the environmental considerations and findings of the assessment presented in the Environmental Report have been taken into account in the plan or programme (in this case, the plan is the Active Cairngorms Action Plan).
- 2. Taking account of consultation responses: how the opinions and results of relevant consultations have been taken into account (in this case, the responses to the consultations on the scoping report and draft Environmental Report that accompanied the Active Cairngorms Action Plan).
- 3. Consideration of alternatives: the reasons for choosing the plan or programme as adopted, in the light of the other reasonable alternatives considered.
- 4. Monitoring of environmental effects: the measures that are to be taken to monitor the significant environmental effects of the implementation of the plan or programme.

This report seeks to address these four questions.

#### Taking account of the environmental assessment

Environmental issues were considered from the outset and throughout the preparation of the Active Cairngorms Action Plan, being an integral part of the preparation process. The Environmental Assessment process (and Habitats Regulations Appraisal) have been used to inform the contents of the plan. Actions to safeguard the natural and cultural heritage of the National Park, support economic opportunities and improve health and wellbeing of people are included within the ACAP. In addition, the Active Cairngorms Action Plan is a subset of the National Park Partnership Plan, subject to SEA and HRA, and as such is identified as delivering key environmental issues relevant to the Park area

# Taking account of consultation responses

There were no public consultation responses to the draft Environmental Report. The consultation authorities accepted the draft report as written and provided no specific changes or amendments.

#### **Consideration of alternatives**

The National Park Partnership Plan, subject to SEA and HRA, set out the requirement to develop, consult and adopt an Active Cairngorms Action Plan. Therefore no alternatives were considered in the development of the ACAP Environmental Report.

## Monitoring of environmental effects

Monitoring is only required if significant adverse effects are identified. Monitoring will take place through the NPP framework. No negative effects were predicted to occur as a result of implementation of the ACAP (see annex1).
